

TRAFFIC ALERT: PennDOT has issued the following press release announcing lane restrictions along Perkiomen Avenue starting TOMORROW, 4/24/19:

County: Berks

Municipality: Exeter Township, St. Lawrence/Mount Penn boroughs

Road name: Perkiomen Avenue/ Business Route 422 West

Between: Neversink Road and Exeter Township/St. Lawrence Borough line

Type of work: Construction

Work being done by: PennDOT Contractor

Type of restriction: 24 Hours

Restriction: As part of the ongoing Perkiomen Reconstruction Project, westbound traffic will be switched to a split lane configuration. Traffic in the right lane will only be able to continue on Business Route 422 or make right turns. Traffic in the left lane will only be able to continue on Business Route 422 or make left turns at only 36th and 37th streets.

Start date: 4/24/19

Est completion date: 05/15/19

Will rain cause delays? No

Change/Update:

Westbound traffic will be one lane from 7am-5pm on workdays. The traffic split will begin at 5pm and continue to 7am. When the traffic split is in effect, if you are traveling WB and in the left lane, you will only be able to go straight or make a left turn at 36th or 37th Street. If you are traveling WB in the right lane, you will only be able to go straight or make right turns. Traffic splits can be confusing, and lead to increased back-ups so please exercise caution.

It is highly recommended to avoid this area of Perkiomen Avenue, if possible. Expect significant delays on Wednesday, April 24th as crews work to change over the project configuration. Delays and congestion are expected to continue through the duration of this phase. Thank you for your continued patience; please drive safely.
